<p>Igneous Criteria: Formed from slow-cooling magma</p> <p>Speckled with large mineral grains</p> <p>Volcanic rock with many holes; light enough to float</p> <p>Dark volcanic rock; shiny-like glass; sharp edges</p>			
<p>Sedimentary Criteria: Made underwater from the shells of animals; can have many fossils</p> <p>Made from layers of sand; fine, grainy texture</p> <p>Formed when layers of mud and clay are pressed together</p>			
<p>Metamorphic Criteria: Can be made from granite; wavy bands of dark and light layers</p> <p>Rock made from shale; splits easily into flat sheets</p> <p>Colored layers may be made smooth and shiny; formed from limestone</p>
